Field:

The tournament will be played at the LIONS FIELDS located on Thompson Road, south of Main Street. (We play on fields #1 & 2, the side by side fields that we have been playing on all season).

Rules:

The Rules and Regulations for the tournament are the same rules from our summer league, with the exception of the game length as the halves will be shortened (see **Tournament Set-up** below).

ALL GAMES MUST START PROMPTLY at the respective start time. Failure to produce a minimum of 7 players at the start time of each game will result in a 1-0 loss by default.

All players in the tournament must **be officially registered on their respective teams**. ALL players must have photo ID with them. If the appropriate documents are not presented and one or more players are not officially registered on their team, the offending team will forfeit the game, with a score assigned of 5-0. This is to encourage fair practice among teams.

Costs: There are no player fees for the tournament.

Food:

Catering has not been confirmed so please bring your own lunch/snacks/drinks. There is a possibility that a chip truck will be at the park so bring some cash with you just in case you want to purchase food.

Tournament Set Up (Round Robin, Semi-finals and Final):

Round Robin

Every team will play a minimum of two games in total, each playing all teams in their respective pool. Each game will consist of **2 x 20 minute halves**, with a 5 minute half time.

Game points are calculated as follows: **WIN = Three (3) points, TIE = One (1) point.**

At the end of the round robin games, teams finishing in 1st and 2nd place in their pool will play in the semi-final. If there is a tie for 1st and/or 2nd after the round robin, the following method will be used to break the tie:

1. Team with best goal difference from the tournament (i.e. goals for minus goals against);
2. If still tied, team with most goals for, from the tournament;
3. If still tied, team with least goals against, from the tournament;
4. Best record in games played in regular season, strictly number of wins and losses.
5. If still tied, coin toss.



Semi-Finals

The semi-finals will be played at 2:30 pm and will consist of **2 x 20 minute halves**, with a 5 minute half time. If the game is tied after 40 minutes of play, each team will take five (5) penalty shots. **SEE PENALTY SHOT RULES BELOW.**

Final

The Final will be played at 4:30 pm and will consist of **2 x 25 minute halves**, with a 5 minute half time. If the game is tied after 50 minutes of play, each team will take five (5) penalty shots. **SEE PENALTY SHOT RULES BELOW.**

Penalty Shot Rules:

. The goalie cannot be substituted before or during the penalty shots. Only players who are on the field at the end of the game can qualify to take a penalty shot. The referee will note the jersey numbers of the five (5) chosen players for each team before the start of the penalty shots. If the game remains tied after both teams have taken five (5) penalty shots, the winner will be determined by sudden death penalty shots. For sudden death penalty shots, each team will choose (1) one player from the remaining players on the field, and this process will repeat until a winner has been determined. If a team goes though ALL players on the field during the sudden death penalty shots, the player picking process starts over.

Awards Presentation:

ALL TEAMS please arrive promptly at 12:30pm

Awards for MVP, Best Sportsperson, League champs and top goal scorer of the season will be presented at the presentation area starting at 12:30 pm, ending no later than 1:00pm.

ALL TEAMS MUST ARRIVE PROMPTLY AT 12:30 pm for the awards.

Each team is to nominate a Most Valuable Player and Best Sportsperson. All teams are required to have submitted their MVP and BSP player names no later than September 15th to Heather D'Ospina at seniors@miltonsoccer.com

Jersey Return:

Please return your jersey to your team manager at the end of the tournament. If a player is not attending the tournament it is up to the team manager to collect the jersey from those player(s). Each team manager must collect ALL 25 team jerseys, bring them home and wash them, and keep them until contacted by Heather D'Ospina.
